### ***SECTION 4-1. LICENSE REQUIRED***

From and after May 1<sup>st</sup>, 1969, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a bicycle on any street in the village unless the same has been inspected and registered by an authorized police officer at the office of the Chief of Police, or at such other place as shall be designated. A fee of \$.50 shall be charged for such inspection and registration.

### ***SECTION 4-2. INSPECTION***

No bicycle shall be registered unless it shall, on inspection, be found mechanically safe. An identification tag shall be affixed to each registered bicycle, and such tag shall not be removed, therefrom except by a duly authorized police officer.

### ***SECTION 4-3. RENEWAL***

Bicycles shall be registered, inspected and tagged annually for the period from September 1<sup>st</sup> in any year to September 1<sup>st</sup> in the following year.

### ***SECTION 4-4. TRANSFER***

In case of transfer of ownership of a registered bicycle the person to whom it is transferred shall have the same registered. If a registered bicycle is dismantled or destroyed or otherwise removed from operation, the person in whose name it was registered shall report such fact to the Chief of Police.

### ***SECTION 4-5. CANCELLATION***

If any bicycle shall be operated on the street of the Village in an unsafe manner or in violation of law, the Chief of Police is authorized, at his discretion, to cancel the registration of such bicycle and remove the identification tag thereof. Such cancellation shall be separate from, and in addition to, any other penalty provided in such case.

**SECTION 4-6. LOST TAGS**

Tags shall not be transferred from one bicycle to another and no person shall attach to any bicycle a tag not issued for use thereon. Upon loss of any such tag or duplicate, and upon application and satisfactory evidence of such loss, a new tag or new duplicate shall be issued upon payment of a fee of \$.25.

**SECTION 4-7. EQUIPMENT**

All bicycles operated or driven upon any public street in the Village shall be equipped as provided by Law.

**SECTION 4-8. PENALTY**

Any violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$10.00 or the Court may prohibit such person from riding a bicycle for a period not to exceed six months and may order such person's identification tag confiscated.
