SECTION 19-1. WRITTEN PERMISSION REQUIRED

No person, firm or corporation shall establish or maintain any filling storage station, tank or other container of kerosene or other inflammable or combustible material within the corporate limits of the Village without first obtaining a written permit therefor from the Village Board. Said Village Board shall not issue such permit without first holding a public hearing thereon, of which at least seven (7) days notice shall be given by publication in a public newspaper published in said Village.

SECTION 19-2. EXCLUSION FROM PERMIT

No permit shall be required for the storage of fuel in suitable containers not exceeding five (5) gallons in capacity for use in lawn mowers, vehicles or garden tools; or for fuel oil used for heating purposes only stored in an underground or basement tank inspected by a proper officer of the fire department at the time of storage.

SECTION 19-3. PENALTY

A person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be guilty of an offence.

SECTION 19-4. FEE

The fee for issuing such a permit shall be \$15.00 for each application.
