SECTION 46-1. NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON LOCAL LAWS

No Local law shall be passed by the Village Board of the Village of Arcade until a public hearing thereon has been held before the Board of trustees of the Village. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, such a public hearing shall only be held on public notice of at least three (3) days, exclusive of the date of the hearing.

SECTION 46-2. PUBLICATIONS OF ABSTRACTS OF LOCAL LAWS

Pursuant to the authority granted by Section (1)(ii)(e)(3) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding, it shall be sufficient if the Village of Arcade, in any case in which it may be required or permitted by Statute to publish in one or more newspapers any local law which such Village is or may be authorized by law to adopt, to publish in such newspapers a summary describing the subject of such local law and a notice stating that the whole of such local law is on file with the Village Clerk of the Village of Arcade, provided that a copy of such local law is kept on file with the Village Clerk during the period of such publication in lieu of publishing such local law in full in such newspaper or newspapers. Nothing herein contained shall dispense with any posting of any such local laws which is or may be required or permitted by law.

SECTION 46.3. EFFECTIVE DATE OF CERTAIN LOCAL LAWS

1. Except as otherwise provided by law, no local law enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Arcade shall become effective until filed with the Comptroller of the State of New York and the New York Department of State.
2. Except as otherwise provided by law, no local law amending, supplementing or changing the Zoning Law of the Village of Arcade shall become effective until ten (10) days after publication of the abstract authorized by Section 46-2 in the official newspaper and posting of a copy of such abstract of the local law at or near the main entrance to the office of the Village Clerk; provided, however, that such a local law shall take effect for the date of its service as against a person personally served with a copy of said abstract.
3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
