VILLAGE INSULATION PROGRAM

In order to improve energy conservation and address electricity supply issues associated with electrically heated homes, the Village of Arcade Electric Department, in conjunction with the Independent Energy Efficiency Program (IEEP) has implemented the **Village Insulation Program (VIP)**. This program provides free attic insulation installation for qualified homeowners.

This program benefits our residential customers with electrically heated homes by helping them increase the R-value of the insulation in the attic to. After the additional insulation is installed, customers should see lower electrical usage and thus lower costs in future years. The VIP is another customer benefit program supporting our residential customers. As long as the following criteria are met, there is little or no cost to customers.

Criteria for Participation

- Home is to be electrically heated by Arcade Electric
- Winter use as measured in Kilowatt hours (kwh) must be at least double the summer use (kwh)

Customer agrees to:

- Participate in insulation program if all criteria are met

Arcade Electric Agrees to:

- Provide for program coordination through the IEEP
- Provide for the inspection of the attic insulation prior to allowing the customer to participate in the program
- Arrange for the contractor to install the appropriate insulation
- Provide for the inspection of the attic after installation of the new insulation
- Pay the contractor for the installation of the insulation
- Pay any costs for any required ventilation and air sealing in the attic

Sign up for the program by calling the IEEP at (315) 463-7208. There is a limit to the funding so the first to call will be the first to be served.
