**PROJECT UPDATES**

SPW Bartz updated the Board on various projects in the departments.

Liberty St: NYSDOT just signed off on PO for the mill and fill project last Friday. County Line Stone won the bid and D&H will be the paving contractor. Should be completed in the next few weeks.

Darren Harvill, NYSDOT Resident Engineer, called to tell me the secondary contractor to do the culvert pipe work will not get to fix them until after the paving is completed.

We are having an issue with Main St. where we had the water main break from the fire at Brauen's. The pavement keeps sinking so we have to re-open the site and try to see if there is a bigger issue underneath. NYSDOT will provide some traffic control when we do the work. We will coordinate the work in the next few weeks.

Maple St and West St. paving has been completed today, looks great.

**SNOW REMOVAL PROCEDURE**

The Board along with the SPW and the Streets Foreman are working together to come up with a clear plan for snow removal with public safety being the number one priority. This has been brought about due to the rising costs of gas, equipment, and labor. The Board is reviewing the process to ensure efficiency within the department that allows the work to be completed in a timely and cost-effective manner. Chief Krist will also be included in this discussion.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Donna Schiener, as Mayor of the Village, is hereby authorized to execute all documents that may be required to effectuate the listing for the sale and transfer of all right, title and interest of the Village in said property, with any contract for sale generated by said listing to be subject to the further review and approval of the Board of Trustees.
